

FALL SEMESTER 2009 IMPORTANT DATES AND DEADLINES

NOTE: The deadlines below are for full-term classes. Deadlines for short-term classes vary with the length of the class. Most deadlines are mandated in the CA Code of Regulations and are a percentage of the length of the class.

Beginning April 15	New and returning students may file admission application
July 6 – July 20	Priority registration for continuing and re-enrolling students
July 21	Registration begins for students new to IVC and continues for current and former IVC students
July 23	Registration begins for students concurrently enrolled in grades K-12
August 23	Residency determination date
August 24	Classes begin. Beginning on first day each class meets, add authorization code from instructor required to register for that class, filled or open

August 24 – September 5	Late Registration. Beginning on first day each class meets, add authorization code from instructor required to register for that class, filled or open.
September 5	Deadline to register for full-term courses Deadline to drop full-term classes without owing fees and/or be eligible for refund Deadline to select CR/NC grading option for courses with that option (see section on <i>Change Grading Options</i>). Does not pertain to Non-credit Program courses.
September 7	Deadline to drop without course appearing on transcript (without receiving W). Note: fees will be charged and no refunds given for courses dropped on September 6 or 7. See Sept. 5.
September 7	Holiday – Labor Day; no classes

September 8	Census
September 8	Ticketing for parking violations in student spaces on main campus begins. <u>Note:</u> tickets are issued for reserved (faculty/staff), disabled, metered, 15-minute, and no-parking spaces year around.
October 2	Deadline to make up incomplete grade (I) granted Spring or Summer 2009
October 27	Financial Aid Return to Title IV drop deadline
October 30	Deadline to submit <i>Petition for Graduation</i> for degree to be awarded Fall 2009. Completed petition must be received in Admissions & Records Office by this date. Students must meet with a Counselor and have an evaluation completed and petition signed before this date.
November 9	Holiday – In Honor of Veterans’ Day; no classes

November 13	Deadline to drop full-term classes
