






As of today, are you attending college full-time or part-time?





In the past year, what classes have you primarily been enrolled in at the college?





In the past year, what modality of classes have you been enrolled in at the college?




How many years have you been in college?



Thinking about the past academic year, which of the following best describes your grades?




Thinking about all of your jobs, on average, about how much do you earn an hour?








In the past 12 months, how many times have you moved?




In the past 12 months, have you stayed in an unhealthy relationship to have somewhere to live?



In the past 12 months, did you leave your household because you felt unsafe?




How safe do you feel where you currently live?




In the past 12 months, have you ever been homeless?



In the past 12 months, did you couch surf that is, moved from one temporary housing arrangement to another because you had no other place to live?




Is your home in a public housing project, owned by a local housing authority or other public agency?





Do you receive a public housing voucher, such as Section 8, to subsidize the cost of private housing?




Do you have any biological, adopted, step, or foster children who live in your household?



Please indicate the number of biological, adopted, step, or foster children who live in your household.




Do you consider yourself to be a single parent?





In the last 30 days, did you ever cut the size of your meals or skip meals because there wasn't enough money for food?




In the last 30 days, how often did this happen (you cut the size of your meals or skipped meals because there wasn't enough money for food)?



In the last 30 days, did you ever eat less than you felt you should because there wasn't enough money for food?




In the last 30 days, were you ever hungry but didn't eat because there wasn't enough money for food?

In the last 30 days, did you lose weight because there wasn't enough money for food?







In the last 30 days, did you stay in an unhealthy relationship so you or you and your family would have enough food?




In the last 30 days, did you ever not eat for a whole day because there wasn't enough money for food?





In the last 30 days, how often did this happen (your children skipped meals due to lack of money or food)?





Are you aware of a Basic Needs Center on your campus and/or ways to access basic needs support (i.e., food, housing, mental health, physical health, childcare, transportation)?







In the past year, have you received basic needs assistance from your college in any of the following areas? (Select all that apply)





To what degree do you rely on the food supports provided by your college to support you?





To what degree do you rely on the housing supports provided by your college to support you?





To what degree do you rely on the physical health supports provided by your college to support you?



To what degree do you rely on the childcare supports provided by your college to support you?



To what degree do you rely on the transportation supports provided by your college to support you?





To what degree do you rely on the public benefit application supports provided by your college to support you?








Have you ever been convicted of a crime? (Please don't count minor traffic violations.)



How many years have passed since your last conviction?




Are you currently on probation or parole?







Are you a U.S. citizen or permanent resident?





Have you ever served in the U.S. Armed Forces, Military Reserves, or National Guard?




How do you usually describe your race and/or ethnicity? (check all that apply)




