

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

Throughout October, the Career Services Center team conducted Career Development Workshops for students. Topics included Résumé Building, Interview Preparation, and Workability Skills.

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

OPPOSED BILLS PASSED

- AB 1028 (Fong): Community colleges: temporary employees

OPPOSED BILLS FAILED

- AB 90 (Jackson): Overnight student parking

SUPPORTED BILLS FAILED

- AB 537 (Ahrens): California Community College Promise

- AB 731 (Fong): Pupil instruction: dual enrollment: College and Career Access Pathways partnerships

SUPPORTED BILLS PASSED

- AB 323 (Fong): Strong Workforce Program: work-based learning opportunities

- SB 761 (Ashby): CalFresh student eligibility

SUPPORTED BILLS VETOED

- AB 1400 (Soria): Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing Pilot Program (amended to add priority for Inland Empire, add co-authors, and amend down to 10 districts)
