

SPRING 2027 8-WEEK CLASSES IMPORTANT DATES AND DEADLINES

Beginning October 1	New and former students may file an admission application for Winter/Spring 2027 and/or Summer/Fall 2027.
November 9	Priority registration begins
February 12	Holiday – Lincoln’s Birthday. No classes.
February 15	Holiday – Washington’s Birthday. No classes.
February 15	Residency determination date.
February 16	Spring classes begin. Late Registration. Beginning on the first day each class meets, add authorization code from instructor required to register for that class, filled or open.
February 25	Deadline to register for 1st 8-week session classes. Deadline to select P/NP grading option for courses with that option.
February 26	Deadline to drop Spring 1st 8-week session classes without a W and no fees.
March 1	Ticketing for parking violations in student spaces on main campus begins.
March 12	Financial Aid Freeze Date - Units enrolled as of this date will be used to determine enrollment status for financial aid payment
March 27	Deadline to drop 1st 8-week session classes.
March 29 – April 3	Spring Recess. No classes.
April 16	Deadline to submit <i>Petition for Graduation</i> for degree to be awarded for Spring and Summer 2027 and participate in Commencement. Students must meet with a Counselor and have an evaluation completed before this date.
April 17	1st 8-week session ends.
April 19	2nd 8-week session begins.
April 28	Deadline to register for 1st 8-week session classes. Deadline to select P/NP grading option for courses with that option.
April 29	Deadline to drop Spring 2nd 8-week session classes without a W and no fees.
May 28	Deadline to drop 2nd 8-week session classes.
April	Deadline to submit <i>Petition for Graduation</i> for degree to be awarded for Spring and Summer 2027 and participate in Commencement. Students must meet with a Counselor and have an evaluation completed before this date.
May 31	Holiday – Memorial Day. No classes.
June 11	2nd 8-week session ends.
June 11	Deadline to apply to receive degree or certificate at end of Spring Intersession and not participate in Commencement.
