

## **WINTER INTERSESSION 2022**

### **IMPORTANT DATES AND DEADLINES**

**NOTE:** The deadlines below are for full-term classes. Deadlines for short-term classes vary with the length of the class. Most deadlines are mandated in the CA Code of Regulations and are a percentage of the length of the class.

<b>Beginning October 1</b>	New and former IVC students may file admission application for Winter/Spring 2022 and/or Summer/Fall 2022.
<b>November 8</b>	Priority registration begins.
<b>December 20 – January 2</b>	College closed for winter recess.
<b>January 2</b>	Residency determination date for Winter Intercession
<b>January 3</b>	<b>Classes begin for Winter Intercession.</b> Beginning on the first day each class meets, add authorization code from instructor required to register for that <u>Winter class</u> , filled or open.

<b>January 3 - 5</b>	<b>Late Registration for Winter Intercession.</b> <u>Beginning on the first day each class meets, add authorization code from instructor required to register for that Winter class, filled or open.</u>
<b>**January 5**</b>	<b>Deadline to register for Winter Intercession full-term courses.</b>
<b>January 5</b>	<b>Deadline to select P/NP grading option for Winter Intercession courses with that option</b> (see section on <i>Change Grading Options</i> ). Does not pertain to Non-credit Program courses.

<b>January 9</b>	<b>Deadline to drop Winter Intercession full-term classes without owing fees and/or be eligible for refund.</b>
<b>January 10</b>	Ticketing for parking violations in student spaces on main campus begins. <u>Note:</u> tickets are issued for reserved (faculty/staff), disabled, metered, 15-minute, and no-parking spaces year around.
<b>January 10</b>	<b>Census.</b>
<b>January 17</b>	Holiday – Martin Luther King Day. College closed. No classes.

<b>**January 26**</b>	<b>Deadline to drop Winter Intercession courses.</b>

<b>February 3</b>	<b>Deadline to apply to receive degree or certificate at end of Winter Intercession.</b> Completed petition must be received in Admissions & Records Office by this date. Students must meet with a Counselor and have an evaluation completed and petition signed before this date.
<b>February 3</b>	Winter Intercession final exams; last day of Winter Intercession.
