IV. Discussion and Information Items

A. Visioning Update (Bill Gay) – Attachment A

PIO Bill Gay presented a PowerPoint entitled Visioning 2017/18. He provided a brief history of the visioning meetings which began in 2004 and were held out in the community. He stated that due to low attendance throughout the last visioning cycle, the District felt it needed to make a change and decided to hold meetings on campus by stakeholder groups. The stakeholder groups consisted of migrant parents, ESL students, transfer students, ASG, senior citizens, the agriculture community, high school counselors and principals, as well as elected officials. He stated there were 272 attendees and that more than 1,000 comments had been accumulated.

He went over the feedback provided by the meeting participants, including the compliments, as well as the challenges and opportunities that came up during the meetings.

A lengthy discussion ensued regarding the four main topics discussed at the visioning meetings: 1) communication and connectivity; 2) services and programs; 3) transportation; and 4) facilities.

Chair Chronister stated the item would be brought back for further discussion in the fall.

B. First Reading: College Council Self-Evaluation Form (Melody Chronister) – Attachment B

Chair Chronister presented the first reading of the College Council Self-Evaluation Form. The members provided feedback regarding the five future goals listed and agreed to keep three of the five goals:

1. Assess the Council’s connection with the Professional Development committee as a subcommittee of College Council, to see what changes should be made to improve communication and results;
2. Increase participation in the Guided Pathways initiative through the Outcomes Committee; and
3. Solidify outcome of the five recommendations made, reviewing overall recommendation process to determine if efficiencies can be made to close the loop.

Chair Chronister stated the committee would vote to approve the Self-Evaluation at the next meeting scheduled on May 23, 2018.
