



2017–2018 Verification Worksheet Dependent Student (V5)

Your 2017–2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, we will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and a parent whose information was reported on the FAFSA must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid office. We may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact us as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

E. High School Completion Status

- If you are a homeschooled student from a state that requires a homeschooled student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a copy of that credential.
- If you are a homeschooled student from a state that does not require a homeschooled student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript or the equivalent, signed by you parent or guardian, that lists the secondary school courses you completed and includes a statement of your successful completion of a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.

If you are unable to obtain the documentation listed above, you must contact the financial aid office.

F. Identity and Statement of Educational Purpose (To be Signed at IVC Financial Aid Office)

You must appear in person at Imperial Valley College to verify your identity by presenting a valid government-issued photo identification (ID), such as, but not limited to, a driver’s license, other state-issued ID, or passport. IVC will maintain a copy of your photo ID that is annotated with the date it was received and reviewed and the name of the official at IVC authorized to collect the ID.
