Reports, discussion and action included the following:

- ACCJC Meeting Attended by Dr. Gould. Dr. Gould attended the Accrediting Commission's meeting in January to request clarification regarding the recommendation that the college develop SLO's by the October 15, 2009 progress report deadline. The Commission's findings from the December visit will be available in February.
- EMPC Co-Chair. Suzanne Gretz volunteered to serve as the faculty Co-Chair of the Educational Master Plan Committee. All present voted in favor of the appointment. Kathy explained that the Commission prefers that administration and faculty co-chair such a committee. Serving as Co-Chair entails working on timelines, and assisting with the writing of documents. The Educational Master Plan Committee will meet at least once a month following completion of the plan, and every two weeks before then.
- Program Review Status. Comprehensive program reviews are due January 23, 2009, with the annual program reviews due on January 21. Discussion took place regarding the difference between annual and comprehensive program reviews. The committee agreed that because program review is tied to budget development, the program review process could not begin before January.
