

BILL THORNBURG HONORED




Photo of Victor Jaime presenting framed certificate to Bill's wife, Evelyn.

ing) board member, faculty member, and vice president. Official ceremonies marking this designation will be held in the spring.



AROUND CAMPUS

1. The Foundation will be distributing \$17K to over 50 different students for Spring semester scholarships.
