- 1) Program Level Outcomes- PLOs. Sydeny, Diane, Don and Josefina had worked on PLOs at a workshop at the end of Spring 2012. They had come up with the following 2 PLOs :
 - a. Students will be able to write a complete paragraph (8-10 sentences) with an identifiable main idea and three supporting details using correct grammar and mechanics.
 - b. Students will be able to listen to a passage in English and respond to it, demonstrating their ability to understand the main idea and provide opinions, reasons, and examples using clear and accurate pronunciation and grammar.

In the meeting we discussed the PLOs and Kseniya suggested that the third PLO needed to assess reading as the other two assessed grammar/composition and speaking/listening. We changed the wording on the first two SLOs and the timing of the PLOs was taken into consideration as we discussed what the PLOs should assess. We decided that the 1st PLO should be assessed Fall 2012 and the other two Spring 2013. The three PLOs for the ESL program will be:

- 1. Outcome #1:** Students will produce a paragraph (8-10 sentences) that demonstrates their ability to use a standard academic organizational pattern, topic sentence, supporting sentences, and concluding sentence using correct grammar and punctuation.

Outcome #2: Students will produce a speech/presentation (3-5 minutes) that demonstrates their ability to communicate the main idea, provide opinions, reasons and examples using clear and accurate pronunciation and grammar.

Outcome #3: Students will produce a graphic organizer based on a reading passage that demonstrates their ability to understand the text structure including main ideas and major and minor details.
