#### 1) Updates

#### a) Instructional

- Michael Heumann shared with the group that the Academic Senate had approved changing our Learning Management Systems provider from Etudes to Blackboard. The recommendation will be going before the Board of Trustee on May 16<sup>th</sup> for approval.
- The ATLAS Innovations 2012 Conference is now accepting applications for the conference which will be held on August 14-15, 2012. To date 14 faculty have signed up.
- ATLAS Innovation 2012 Conference first day will focus on learning the nuts and bolts of the Blackboard platform and day two will focus on classroom innovations.
- Attendees will receive a stipend for attending the August Conference with an
  opportunity to become Trainers. Attendees will also be expected to work with
  mentors during the fall and spring semesters to develop new and innovative
  teaching approaches.
- There was discussion about the logistics of transferring data to Blackboard.
   Michael Heumann indicated that module and discussions can be exported into Blackboard.
- Sidne Horton asked whether there would be on campus student support for Blackboard. Jeff Enz indicated that there would be student support through Blackboard, whether it would be on campus or not would need to be discussed further.
- ATLAS would be covering the difference between Etudes yearly maintenance fee and Blackboard's first year maintenance cost. The increased cost during Year 1-3 will be covered by the ATLAS Grant. This would be an expense of \$23,000.00 a year.

- The group discussed summer meetings and scheduling one meeting once a month to prepare for the August Conference.

# i) TutorTrac

- Jeff Enz stated he is waiting on the software download and would followup with Edward Cesena and give an update at the next meeting.
- Jeff Cantwell indicated that once the software is moved to the virtual server, he will need to load the rosters from Banner into the TutorTrac server.

### ii) Wireless

 Jeff Enz reported that his team is working on the external access points and in the next week and he will be sending out communication to the campus community.
