Rules

The Rules Committee made the following recommendation to the Royalty Act of 1968. The first reading was approved during the March 25, 2013 meeting. Parliamentarian Ortega provided copies for the second reading.

Currently reads as: "Royalty may be selected for the traditional Arab Sweetheart Dance held during the year. There may be a "queen" or "sweetheart" and tow princesses, except in cases of a tie in the voting. In such cases there may be up to four princesses."
