**SDSU-Imperial Valley School of Nursing Cross Enrollment Program with Imperial Valley College**  
Associate Degree RN (ADRN) to Registered Nurse Bachelor of Science (RN-BS) degree in Nursing Program

**Are you newly admitted to the IVC ADRN program? Is this your first bachelor's degree?**

If you answered yes to these two questions, you may be eligible to take classes at both IVC and SDSU IV that will allow you to finish your BS in Nursing degree within 6-8 months of finishing the ADRN.

A Cross Enrollment program exists between the Imperial Valley College Associate Degree RN (ADRN) and San Diego State University Imperial Valley's Registered Nurse-Bachelor's of Science (RN-BS) in Nursing degree program. Students accepted into the ADRN, can begin the cross enrollment process as soon as they are registered for their 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the ADRN program. The process is simple and will only cost \$52 (processing fee) to take 1 class each semester at SDSU IV while in the ADRN program. Advising is available throughout the entire process through SDSU Imperial Valley. Hundreds of students have taken advantage of this inexpensive, quality program. When finished with the ADRN, the total cost of the BS in Nursing degree is less than \$7000.

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To graduate from SDSU with a BS in Nursing & PHN (your title will be RN, BSN, PHN), you must complete:

1. GE (3 classes) \*1 can be completed while in ADRN
2. WPA (Exam to see if you can test out of extra writing courses once you are done at IVC)
3. RN-BS Courses (6 classes) \*3 can be completed while in the ADRN
4. International Experience Requirement (currently waived R/T COVID)

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1. **Upper Division General Education (Explorations) 9 units** \*Cross Enroll in either 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of ADRN

Group A: Natural Sciences/

Group B: Social & Behavioral Sciences/ \* also counts as cultural diversity course

Group C: Humanities/

\*also counts as an ethnic studies course

Semester:

- Take 1 class from each category.
- At least one must be a cultural diversity course and one must be an ethnic studies course which is outlined in the general catalog. 2. **Writing Placement Assessment (WPA)** Take exam during the first semester you are admitted to SDSU IV

3. **RN-BS in Nursing Courses (26 units) + 15 units of credit are granted once proof of RN license is received.**

NUR 312 (3U) Professional Nursing (Fall or Spring) \*1<sup>st</sup> semester of ADRN

The course is hybrid (only meets select Saturdays) & no textbook is required.

NUR 307 (3U) Nursing Research (Fall or Spring) \*2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of ADRN

\*You must have already completed a statistics course before taking.

The course is hybrid (only meets select Saturdays)

NUR 320 & L (4U) Health Assessment (Fall or Spring) \*4<sup>th</sup> semester of ADRN

The course is hybrid. The lecture is online and there is a weekly 4-hour lab.

**The above courses are pre-requisite courses for the clinical courses below.**

NUR 415 & L (5U) Community Health (Summer)

NUR 458 & L (5U) Leadership & Management (Fall or Spring)

NUR 400 & L (6U) Complex, High Acuity Patients (Fall or Spring)

4. **INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE: Currently waived R/T COVID. Post-COVID, virtual experiences are an option.**

**Total Units Required for the Degree: 120**

(70 from ADRN + 50 from SDSU: We give 15 units for NCLEX, which leaves 35 units of actual coursework (26 RN-BS & 9 from GE)

**Graduation options: May, August or December**

2022 Fees:

Cost of Cross Enrollment: \$52/class

Cost of Tuition/Fees once admitted after you are a licensed RN: \$3200/semester (you will only have 2 semesters of tuition before graduating)

TOTAL cost of BSN is less than \$7000 when you complete at least 3 RN-BS classes at SDSU IV while in the ADRN (N312, N307, N320).

### **Admitted to the ADRN program and registered for 1<sup>st</sup> semester in Fall:**

**Fall: 1<sup>st</sup> semester of ADRN-** Cross Enroll in NURS 312 @ SDSU IV

**Spring: 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of ADRN-** Cross Enroll in NURS 307 or a GE @ SDSU IV: Explorations like NUT 313, NURS 350 or GERO 360

**Fall: 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of ADRN-** Cross Enroll in NURS 307 or a GE @ SDSU IV: Explorations like NUT 313, NURS 350 or GERO 360

*Between October 1-December 15, apply for a fall admission through Cal State Apply to the SDSU IV RN-BS in Nursing program. <https://www.calstate.edu/Apply> Apply for FASFA for SDSU as well: <https://sacd.sdsu.edu/financial-aid>*

**Spring: 4<sup>th</sup> semester of ADRN-** Cross Enroll in NURS 320 @ SDSU IV

**Summer after ADRN:** You can be officially admitted and begin NURS 415/415L and take GE-Explorations while passing NCLEX and getting your first RN job.

**Fall:** Finish final course requirements (WPA, N458/458L, N400/400L, GE) for BS in Nursing and graduate in December (only 6 months after completing the ADRN program!).

**December:** After your degree posts, you can apply for the Public Health Nurse certificate through the California Board of Registered Nursing: <https://www.rn.ca.gov/pdfs/applicants/phn-app.pdf>

### **Admitted to the ADRN program and registered for 1<sup>st</sup> semester in Spring:**

**Spring: 1<sup>st</sup> semester of ADRN-** Cross Enroll in NURS 312 @ SDSU IV

**Fall: 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of ADRN-** Cross Enroll in NURS 307 or a GE @ SDSU IV: Explorations like NUT 313, NURS 350 or GERO 360

**Spring: 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of ADRN-** Cross Enroll in NURS 307 or a GE @ SDSU IV: Explorations like NUT 313, NURS 350 or GERO 360

**Fall: 4<sup>th</sup> semester of ADRN-** Cross Enroll in NURS 320 @ SDSU IV

*Between August 1-October 15, apply for a spring admission through Cal State Apply to the SDSU IV RN-BS in Nursing program. <https://www.calstate.edu/Apply> Apply for FASFA for SDSU as well: <https://sacd.sdsu.edu/financial-aid>*

**Spring: 1<sup>st</sup> semester of admission.** WPA, N458/458L, N400/400L, GE while passing NCLEX and starting first RN job.

**Summer:** Finish final course requirements (N415/415L & GE) for BS in Nursing and graduate in August (8 months after finishing the ADRN at IVC!).

**August:** After your degree posts, you can apply for the Public Health Nurse certificate through the California Board of Registered Nursing: <https://www.rn.ca.gov/pdfs/applicants/phn-app.pdf>
